**ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER ESTABLISHING COST OF SUPERVISION
FOR DEPARTMENT OF CORRECTIONS PROBATION
AND COMMUNITY CONTROL**

WHEREAS, AO 1996-12.3 set forth certain criteria related to the cost of supervision for those sentenced to felony probation in this circuit, including criteria that are now addressed by the Florida Statutes;

WHEREAS, § 948.09, Fla. Stat. provides that any person ordered by the Court to be placed on probation, drug offender probation, or community control subject to Department of Corrections supervision, "must, as a condition of any placement, pay the department a total sum of money equal to the total month or portion of a month of supervision times the court-ordered amount, but not to exceed the actual per diem costs of the supervision";


WHEREAS, it is incumbent upon all offenders to bear, according to their means, the costs of supervision to minimize the economic impact on the taxpayers of the State of Florida;

WHEREAS, each defendant, prior to entering a plea of guilty or nolo contendere, should be aware of the costs of Department of Corrections supervision if probation is to be imposed.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that unless otherwise exempted or ordered by the Court, every defendant placed on felony probation or community control by a judge of the Twelfth Judicial Circuit shall pay the sum of \$50 per month for the cost of Department of Corrections supervision for probation and/or community control, plus the applicable surcharge.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Administrative Order 1996-12.3 is hereby vacated, and superceded by this Administrative Order.
