**ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER REGARDING
INDIGENCY APPLICATION FEE**

WHEREAS Section 27.52, Florida Statutes (Supp. 1996), provides for the imposition of a public defender application fee up to forty dollars (\$40.00) at the time an affidavit of insolvency is filed, or as part of the sentence or condition of probation (hereinafter "indigency application fee"); and

WHEREAS Section 27.52, Florida Statutes (Supp. 1996), provides that the indigency application fee shall be remitted into the county depository and transferred to the Indigent Criminal Trust Fund, if created by law; and

WHEREAS Section 27.525, Florida Statutes (Supp. 1996), created the Criminal Defense Trust Fund; and

WHEREAS it is necessary for the Clerk of the Circuit Court to collect the indigency application fees and transfer such fees into the Indigent Criminal Defense Trust Fund for the benefit of the Public Defender's Office of the Twelfth Judicial Circuit; it is therefore

ORDERED:

Effective January 1, 1997, the Clerks of the Circuit Court in and for Desoto, Manatee and Sarasota Counties are directed to collect indigency application fees and transfer such fees to the Indigent Criminal Defense Fund on a monthly basis.
